



#### INTRODUCTION

The publication of the Confidential File of the Johnson White House gives researchers of Lyndon Johnson and his presidency access to the range of documents and files that the president and his staff believed were too sensitive or potentially embarrassing to be included in the White House Central Files (WHCF). These materials provide an inside perspective on the priorities and concerns of the Johnson administration and on the issues that made it one of the most fascinating and controversial presidential tenures in American history. While Johnson and the Great Society have frequently been examined, the Confidential File opens unexplored areas of study and offers new perspectives on existing research. Publication of the Confidential File, in this accessible form, will greatly impact the understanding of Johnson and the times over which he presided.

Interpreting the context of the Confidential File requires a knowledge of the WHCF, of which it is an integral part. The WHCF have evolved during the twentieth century into the basic way that the president's staff organizes and manages the flow of paper that dominates the day-to-day operations of the modern presidency. During the nineteenth century, records of the presidents were divided into incoming and outgoing mail and kept in chronological order. During the presidencies of Benjamin Harrison (1889–1893) and William McKinley (1897–1901), the increasing volume of mail led White House secretaries to separate documents into categories of importance. When Theodore Roosevelt became president in 1901, the distinction between personal and official correspondence and records became standardized. Clarence Ingling, an officer in the Signal Corps, arranged Roosevelt's files. More important, he and his staff became permanent employees in charge of operating the White House filing system.<sup>1</sup>

During the Taft administration (1909–1913) the process was further revised, using a numerical case file system, organized by assigning record numbers to subjects and names. The case file system operated for the next half century.<sup>2</sup> By the time of John F. Kennedy's election, however, it had become insufficient for managing the increasing volume of information, and it was replaced by the WHCF. The objectives of the new system included expediting the filing process, improving documentation, and aiding the research of future scholars.<sup>3</sup>

The WHCF contained the Subject File, the Name File, the Chronological File, and the Confidential File. The Subject File represented the broadest collection of documents, organized into sixty categories and subjects such as Atomic Energy, Political Affairs, and President. In the Johnson White House, the Federal Government and National Security—Defense files comprised the largest categories, each containing more than 160 linear feet. Within each subject file, documents were also divided into two subcategories: Executive (EX) and General (GEN). Executive documents comprised "correspondence and other papers of particular importance because of source or nature." General materials, although directed to the president, lacked the importance or urgency of Executive documents.<sup>4</sup>

The Confidential File has its own history. As the twentieth century progressed, presidents and their aides decided that some documents were of such national security importance, or involved questions of political sensitivity, that they should not be kept with the regular WHCF. These developments coincided with the emergence of security classifications during

the period around World War II and afterwards. The initial effort at setting up a Confidential File system in the White House, however, seems to have begun during the administration of Herbert Hoover (1929–1933).<sup>5</sup>

The concept of a Confidential File originated with the Hoover administration, and separating sensitive documents became standard practice during World War II. This practice continued within the case file system until Kennedy staffers created the Security Classified File, identified as "national security classified material withdrawn from the WHCF file by the staff of the WHCF Room." This file was organized using the same categories of the new WHCF, and it laid the groundwork for the Johnson administration's expansive Confidential File <sup>6</sup>

It is not yet clear why the Confidential File under Lyndon Johnson grew in scope and content well beyond the Security Classified File of his predecessor. Johnson's dislike of leaks and concern for secrecy undoubtedly contributed to the unprecedented size and depth of the file. Between 1963 and 1969 the Confidential File became a microcosm of the WHCF. Included in the file were documents that might embarrass the administration, strategic information that was revealed only on a need-to-know basis, and materials to which Johnson wished to restrict public access. Once a document was placed in the Confidential File, cross-reference sheets were included in the WHCF indicating that a document had been withdrawn and placed in the Confidential File.

The result of this broad definition of confidentiality is a rich trove of information about the Johnson White House. Almost every issue, from the well-known to obscure, that touched Johnson and his presidency can be found in the Confidential File. Here are documents on Vietnam, civil rights, the Great Society, national politics, economic policy, foreign policy, and many other topics that landed on the president's desk during a time of intense conflict. While the Confidential File is not a substitute for thorough research in the expansive WHCF, it is an immensely enlightening window into the 1960s.

In fact, in the years since scholars have had access to the Confidential File, research into a number of areas has been greatly expanded. Using these documents, historians have shed light on a decade of complicated race relations, Federal Bureau of Investigation surveillance of civil rights leaders, Johnson's relationship with the press corps, his leadership of the Democratic Party, and handling of the war in Vietnam. While the Confidential File will not solve the perennial problem of finding Lyndon Johnson amid the paper trails of his administration, it will enable researchers to gain a solid sense of how his White House operated in times of victory and crisis.<sup>8</sup>

One puzzle that will emerge is why one specific document went into the Confidential File and another did not. The materials in the file are not always self-explanatory on this point. For example, a report from the Research Council in Princeton, New Jersey, dated January 11, 1966, about "Popular Support for the 'Welfare State,'" carried on its cover the word "Confidential," which may then have triggered a filing decision to segregate it in the Confidential File. Its otherwise innocuous information would not have attracted special attention, nor would it have had any special connection with the administration had it become public. One possible area for research is an examination of the documents included and excluded from the Confidential File. The microfilm edition of the Confidential File will facilitate this investigation.<sup>9</sup>

Whatever impulse brought the documents to the Confidential File, now they offer fruitful information for understanding Lyndon Johnson's presidency. In the areas of press relations, politics, and economic policy, for example, the Confidential File is of significant interest. As Kathleen Turner demonstrated, Lyndon Johnson and the press were destined for conflict. As the secretive executive sought to obscure his motives and actions, an intrusive press corps,

suspicious of Johnson and alienated by Vietnam, came to actively distrust the president. As one reporter commented after interviewing Johnson in 1966, it was a unique experience to sit in the White House and have the president lie to him.<sup>10</sup>

Thus the Public Relations (PR) section of the Confidential File contains fascinating material on the topic that did so much to undermine Johnson's standing with the American people. The documents reveal the president's obsession with how the media viewed him and the many campaigns he launched to improve how journalists treated him. During the spring of 1966, Robert E. Kintner, a senior White House aide and former television executive, reported on his conversation with his former colleague and influential syndicated columnist Joseph Alsop. While Alsop chafed "at the secrecy in the appointments," Kintner defended any president's "right to keep secret as long as possible any appointments." Kintner requested Johnson take "as great care as possible in this type of discussion otherwise my link with these people will be broken." Johnson scribbled "Excellent—these memo's are wonderful" on Kintner's memorandum.<sup>11</sup>

The Confidential File also illuminates Johnson's troubled professional and personal relationship with Katharine Graham, publisher of *The Washington Post*. Kintner went to see Graham on behalf of Johnson to explore her side of what had become frosty dealings with the White House. An elaborate process ensued to smooth over the differences between the old friends. With the recent publication of Graham's memoirs, the Confidential File could complete the story of the Johnson-Graham–*Washington Post* relationship, an aspect of 1960s journalism deserving of more attention.<sup>12</sup>

On Lyndon Johnson's economic record, the Confidential File has much significant and valuable information. There are illuminating documents about the internal politics of the Federal Reserve Board during the 1960s, relations between Congress and the Fed, and the administration's economic policy. The sources uncover the irritation that the White House and the Council of Economic Advisers (CEA) felt about the policies and personality of Federal Reserve Chairman William McChesney Martin.

In December 1965, Walter Heller, who had chaired the CEA under Kennedy and briefly in the early months of the Johnson administration, counseled Johnson about an appointment to the Federal Reserve Board from the Midwest. After conceding that a dearth of candidates had not "produced a crop that's ready to harvest," Heller discussed possible chairman candidates when Martin's term expired in 1967. Heller even floated the name of former Treasury Secretary Douglas Dillon who, he contended, "would manage the country's money very much in the Johnson manner." On the other hand, Dillon was "close to the Kennedys, and for this purpose, I don't know whether this is good or bad." 13

A year later, Gardner Ackley, Heller's successor on the CEA, told Johnson after a meeting that "Martin's performance in your office on Monday was disgraceful—his worst in a long time. When he recited to some of his colleagues the economic garbage he had given you, some of them wondered how I had retained my composure—and my lunch." Other documents in the Confidential File shed light on the reasons behind Johnson's decision to reappoint Martin in 1967.<sup>14</sup>

National politics was one of Lyndon Johnson's obsessions, and the Confidential File documents in detail the ebb and flow of the president's electoral fortunes. Few sources offer more insights into Johnson's erratic style as a political leader of the Democrats or contain more revealing indicators about why the party encountered such difficulty during the 1960s. In the spring of 1966, Bill Moyers informed Johnson about efforts to coordinate the upcoming congressional campaign from the White House. At one senior staff meeting, he said that he had "particularly stressed the need for coordinating the efforts of administration spokesmen." The document gives the impression that a cohesive and well-organized approach to the

campaign would be mounted. In fact, the Democratic Party lost badly in the 1966 elections, and the materials in the Confidential File illustrate the gap that opened between what the Johnson White House sought to do in national politics and the fumbling reality of its attempts to stop the erosion of the president's party.<sup>15</sup>

The Confidential File reveals new information on many of the key personal decisions of Johnson's public career, most significantly his abrupt withdrawal from the presidential race in late March 1968. At the beginning of the year, Johnson's political support had reached a low point. He faced a challenge within his own party from Senator Eugene McCarthy of Minnesota, and the possibility of an even more formidable rival in Senator Robert F. Kennedy of New York, and the Vietnam War was splitting the Democrats into warring factions. Unknown to most of Washington, Johnson and his wife had already decided that he would probably not run for reelection in 1968 and they were now debating the best time for such an announcement. The president's uncertain health and his deteriorating stature fueled his decision not to run. Only a few close friends such as Texas governor John B. Connally knew of the president's intentions as the new year opened.<sup>16</sup>

For a time Johnson considered whether his State of the Union address to Congress on January 17, 1968, might be a propitious occasion for his surprise announcement. On the evening of the speech, Johnson's press secretary, George Christian, reported a conversation with John Connally in which he encouraged an announcement, stating "This would be as non-political a setting as we could ever achieve—much different from a news conference or any other speech." The Texas governor laid out other reasons and concluded with an appeal to Johnson's animus against Senator Robert F. Kennedy. "If the decision has been made, the longer you wait the more difficult it becomes; there will be turmoil in any event, but he thinks delay in announcement helps Bobby, who is already free to operate while others are not." In the end, Johnson decided not to make his announcement that night, but Christian's recital of Connally's thinking was one of the elements that shaped Johnson's strategy during the difficult winter. "I

No brief introduction can do justice to the historical insights that will be derived from the wider access to the Confidential File that microfilm publication will provide. From the mass of documentation at the Johnson Presidential Library, this publication presents the most private materials, considered the most critical to strategy and damage control by the administration itself. In a convenient and accessible form, the Confidential File on microfilm opens unexplored areas of study and offers new perspectives on many fields of research.
