

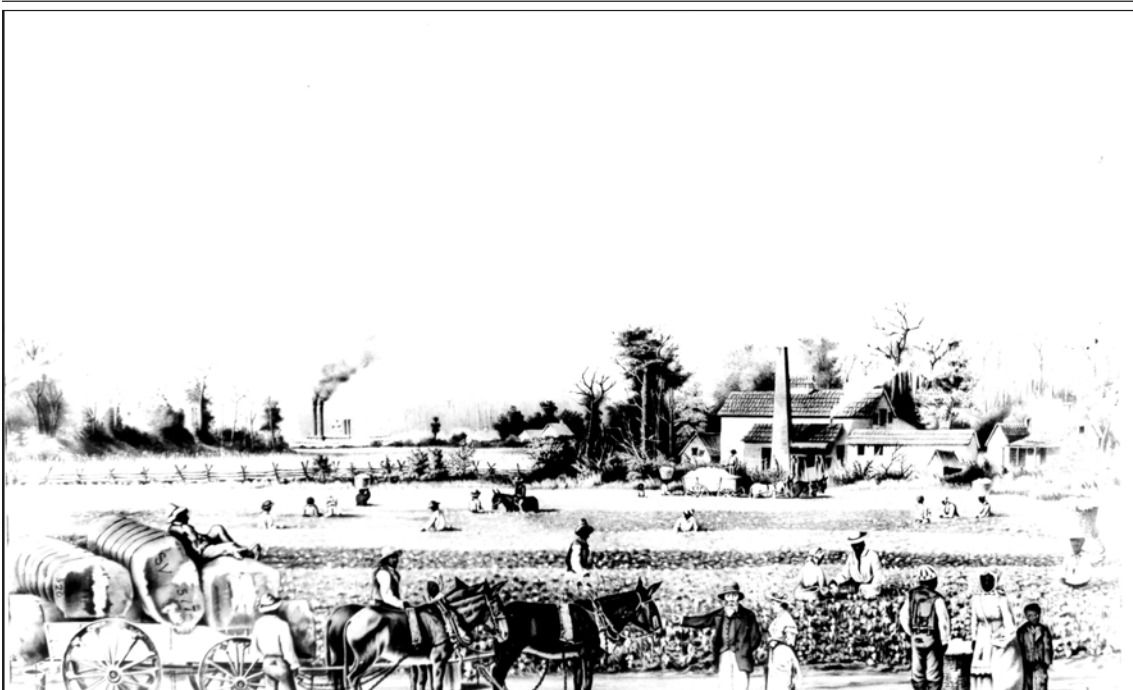

INTRODUCTION

The impact of the ante-bellum southern plantations on the lives of their black and white inhabitants, as well as on the political, economic, and cultural life of the South as a whole, is one of the most fascinating and controversial problems of present-day American historical research. Depending upon the labor of slaves who constituted the great majority of the American black population, the plantations were both homes and business enterprises for a white, southern elite. They were the largest, the most commercialized, and on the whole, the most efficient and specialized agricultural enterprises of their day, producing the bulk of the South's staple crops of tobacco, cotton, sugar, rice, and hemp. Their proprietors were entrepreneurs who aspired to and sometimes, after a generation or two, achieved the status of a cultivated landed aristocracy. Many distinguished themselves not only in agriculture but in the professions, in the military, in government service, and in scientific and cultural endeavors.

Planters ambitious to augment their wealth, together with their black slaves, were an important driving force in the economic and political development of new territories and states in the Southwest. Their commodities accounted for more than half the nation's exports, and the plantations themselves were important markets for the products of northern industry. In short, they played a crucial role in the development of a national market economy.

The plantations of the Old South, the white families who owned, operated, and lived on them, and the blacks who toiled on them as slaves for more than two centuries have been the subjects of numerous historical studies since the pioneering work of Ulrich B. Phillips in the early twentieth century. The literature, highly controversial, has focused on questions such as the evolution and nature of the planter class and its role in shaping the white South's economy, culture, and values; the conditions experienced by American blacks in slavery; the impact of the "peculiar institution" on their personalities and the degree to which a distinct Afro-American culture developed among them; and, finally, the sources of the tension between the proslavery interests of the South and the "free labor" interests of the North that culminated in secession and civil war.

Research materials are plentiful. Census returns and other government documents, newspapers and periodicals, travelers' accounts, memoirs and autobiographies, and an abundance of polemical literature have much to tell historians about life on ante-bellum plantations. The autobiographies of former slaves, several twentieth-century oral history collections, and a rich record of songs and folklore are significant sources for the black experience in slavery. All the historical literature, however, from Phillips to the most recent studies, has relied heavily on the enormous collections of manuscript plantation records that survive in research libraries scattered throughout the South. These manuscripts consist of business records, account books, slave lists, overseers' reports, diaries, private letters exchanged among family members and friends, and even an occasional letter written by a literate slave. They come mostly from the larger tobacco, cotton, sugar, and rice plantations, but a significant number survive from the more modest estates and smaller slaveholdings whose economic operations tended to be less specialized.

Plantation records reveal nearly every aspect of plantation life. Not only business operations and day-to-day labor routines, but family affairs, the roles of women, racial attitudes, relations between masters and slaves, social and cultural life, the values shared by members of the planter class, and the tensions and anxieties that were inseparable from a slave society are all revealed with a fullness and candor unmatched by any of the other available sources. Moreover, these records are immensely valuable for studies of black slavery. Needless to say, since they were compiled by

members of the white master class, they provide little direct evidence of the inner feelings and private lives of the slave population. But they are the best sources of information about the care and treatment of slaves, about problems in the management of slave labor, and about forms of slave resistance short of open rebellion. They also tell us much about the behavior of slaves, from which historians can at least draw inferences about the impact of slavery on the minds and personalities of its black victims.

Deposited in southern state archives and in the libraries of many southern universities and historical societies, significantly more plantation records have become available in recent decades. Our publication is designed to assist scholars in their use by offering for the first time an ample selection of the most important materials in a single microfilm collection. Ultimately it will cover each geographical area in which the plantation flourished, with additions of approximately four new collections annually. A special effort is being made to offer the rarer records of the smaller slaveholders and to include the equally rare records of the plantations in the last quarter of the eighteenth century; however, the documentation is most abundant for the operations of the larger plantations in the period between the War of 1812 and the Civil War, and their records will constitute the bulk of our publication.

EDITORIAL NOTE

The Reel Index for this edition provides the user with a précis of the collections included. The précis for the Cocke Family Papers includes a short biographical note on Thomas Hartwell Cocke, and both the Cocke Family Papers précis and the Breomo Recess Papers précis contain a brief description of some of the major subjects documented in the collections.

Following the précis, the Reel Index lists correspondence by month and year. The four-digit number to the left of each entry indicates the frame number at which a particular folder begins. The first fifty-eight reels of the Cocke Family Papers are composed of correspondence arranged chronologically and spanning from 1725 to 1939. Undated correspondence and miscellaneous papers, also undated, follow on Reels 59 to 61. The Cocke Family Papers also contain bound volumes including cash books, account books, journals, and letterbooks. These bound volumes are arranged chronologically and a brief notation is provided in the Reel Index to describe each one. The diaries of Louisa Maxwell Holmes Cocke, John Hartwell Cocke's second wife, follow the bound volumes. The Cocke Family Papers collection has been filmed in its entirety.

The Breomo Recess Papers begin at Reel 65 and continue to the end of the collection. These papers are arranged chronologically and span from 1689 to 1865. Material in the Breomo Recess Papers dating after 1865 has not been filmed.

Biographical Note

John Hartwell Cocke was born in 1780 in Surry County, Virginia, the son of John Hartwell and Elizabeth Cocke. John Hartwell Cocke attended the College of William and Mary between 1794 and 1799. During his time at William and Mary, he met Anne Blaws Barraud, who was studying music in Williamsburg, Virginia. In 1801, at the age of twenty-one, Cocke took possession of over 5,500 acres of land in Fluvanna and Surry counties. From 1801 to 1802, Cocke lived at Swann's Point in Surry County. In 1802, he married Barraud and also sold his Surry County holdings, moving with his new wife to Fluvanna County, Virginia.

Cocke owned property along the James River known as Bremo. He divided the property into three large plantations, Bremo Recess, Upper Bremo, and Lower Bremo, each consisting of over one thousand acres of land. Cocke lived at Upper Bremo from 1808 until 1855. In 1855, he moved to Lower Bremo where he lived until his death in 1866.

John Hartwell Cocke and Anne Barraud Cocke had six children: John Hartwell (b. 1804); Louisiana Barraud (b. 1806); Philip St. George (b. 1809); Anne Blaws (b. 1811); Cary Charles (b. 1814); and Sallie Faulcon (b. 1816). Anne Barraud Cocke died in December 1816, about three months after the birth of her sixth child. In 1821, Cocke married his second wife, Louisa Maxwell Holmes, who lived with her husband at Upper Bremo until her death in 1843. Thirty-two out of thirty-three volumes of Louisa Maxwell Holmes Cocke's diary are included in this microfilm edition.

As a planter, Cocke's career was characterized by several major pursuits. Like many planters of his day, he was interested in improvements in agricultural practice. In 1817 he helped to found the Agricultural Society of Albemarle. Once he became a full-time planter, Cocke advocated such practices as crop rotation, careful livestock breeding, the use of manures, and reforestation. He also promoted internal improvements by serving on the board of directors of the James River and Kanawha Canal Company. At the same time, and in contrast to many other Virginia-based planters, he waged an aggressive campaign against the cultivation of tobacco. Cocke particularly disliked

tobacco because he saw it as a labor-intensive crop that led the South away from other products and forced the region to rely on the North for many of its basic necessities. He also opposed the cultivation of tobacco because it depleted the soil.

Cocke not only campaigned against tobacco as a cash crop, but criticized its consumption as well. Cocke believed that the use of both tobacco and alcohol was inconsistent with Christian precepts, and his crusade against these products brought him a leadership role in the temperance movement. In 1830, Cocke was elected vice-president of the Virginia Temperance Society, and in 1834 he became president. In 1836 Cocke was also elected president of the United States Temperance Union.

Cocke's religious beliefs and his interest in the temperance movement were just two aspects of a more general reform spirit that characterized his life as well as the lives of many other Americans in the years between the War of 1812 and the Civil War. Following the War of 1812, during which he served as a brigadier general in the Virginia militia, Cocke became involved in several reform movements in addition to temperance. As a close friend of Thomas Jefferson, he helped to establish the University of Virginia and served on the Board of Visitors from 1819 until 1852. Cocke's interest in education also led to involvement in other endeavors, including schools for women and the American Sunday School Union. He even tried to extend the benefits of education to his slaves, establishing a school on his Upper Bremo plantation. His second wife, Louisa Maxwell Holmes Cocke, taught some of the slaves, many of whom learned to read and write.

Cocke's inclusion of his slaves in the educational process is indicative of one of the other important aspects of his career as a planter. He became an early supporter of colonization as a possible course for ridding the United States of slavery. His most formal involvement came through his membership in the American Colonization Society, an organization formed in 1817 to promote the colonization of manumitted American slaves on the west coast of Africa. Cocke served the American Colonization Society as one of its vice-presidents for many years. He also took several personal initiatives in regard to colonization. In 1833, he freed his slave Peyton Skipwith and his family so that they could start a new life in Liberia. In 1840, Cocke sent forty-nine of his slaves to work on his Hopewell and New Hope plantations in Alabama. Cocke intended these plantations to be a training ground for the eventual freedom of his slaves.

Description of the Collection

The Cocke Family Papers are arranged into four series and span from 1725 to 1939 with the bulk of the collection spanning from 1800 to 1865. The first series of the Cocke Family Papers is correspondence, which is arranged chronologically, beginning at Reel 1 and continuing through Frame 0870 of Reel 59. The second series is composed of Miscellaneous papers. The Miscellaneous papers are grouped roughly by subject, beginning at Frame 0871 of Reel 59 and continuing through Frame 0247 of Reel 61. The third series in the Cocke Family Papers consists of bound volumes, which include cash books, account books, journals, and letterbooks. The bound volumes can be found beginning at Frame 0248 of Reel 61 and ending at Frame 0270 of Reel 63. The fourth series comprises the diaries of Louisa Maxwell Holmes Cocke. These diaries begin at Frame 0271 of Reel 63 and continue through the end of Reel 64.

The overwhelming majority of the Cocke Family Papers were generated by John Hartwell Cocke. The collection reflects Cocke's diverse interests and covers a wide range of subjects. The Cocke Family Papers are of outstanding value to students of this time period because they document many different aspects of the system of American slavery. A substantial number of documents relate to Cocke's involvement in the colonization movement and his membership in the American Colonization Society. An 1819 circular (Reel 11, Frame 0692) covers the plans for the first trip to be made in order to establish a colony in Africa. A February 24, 1835, letter (Reel 28, Frame 0131) from Elliott Cresson to Cocke encloses the proceedings of a meeting of the Young Men's Colonization Society of Pennsylvania. Article II of the society's constitution states: "The objects to which its labours shall be devoted are 1. To provide for civilizing and christianizing Africa through the direct instrumentality of Coloured Emigrants from the United States" (Reel 28, Frame 0131). A March 1852 memorandum written by Cocke records his ideas about African colonization, reveals part of his motivation for colonization, and mentions his purchase of land in Alabama to be used to prepare his slaves for their eventual freedom and life in Liberia.

Perhaps the most unique aspect of the Cocke Family Papers is the extent to which the collection documents the lives of Cocke's slaves and former slaves in their own words. The papers include correspondence between several members of the Skipwith family and Cocke beginning in 1833, when Cocke emancipated Peyton Skipwith and his wife, Lydia. A note regarding Skipwith's emancipation and plans to go to Africa can be found at Frame 0533 of Reel 26. Letters from Liberia from Peyton Skipwith, Nash Skipwith, Matilda Lomax, and James Skipwith report on conditions in Liberia, indicate the level of education attained by Cocke's slaves, and also provide insight into the relationship between the slaveowner and his former slaves. Letters from George Skipwith, the slave overseer at Cocke's Hopewell, Alabama, plantation, and from George's daughter, Lucy, who established a school at Hopewell, contain detailed information on the conditions, events, and problems faced on Cocke's plantations in Alabama.

Several other aspects of the system of American slavery are documented in the Cocke Family Papers. Many pieces of correspondence in this collection indicate that Cocke possessed a highly skilled work force. Scattered throughout are letters discussing the hiring out of slaves, many of which include prices to be paid for services rendered. For example, a January 15, 1835, letter from George A. Payne proposes the rate of \$10 per month for an experienced groom to attend to his horse. Documents from 1827 (Reel 17, Frame 0746), 1830 (Reel 22, Frames 0780 and 0877), and 1831 (Reel 24, Frame 0155) record the names of and fees for slaves hired out by Cocke.

The collection also includes a number of documents pertaining to Cocke's rules for governing his slaves, as well as his thoughts on the questions of slavery and abolition. On the subject of plantation oversight, one of the most interesting items is a January 1828 (Reel 19, Frame 0119) discussion of "Regulations to be followed by overseers." In this document, Cocke mentions the need for all slaves to be attired in clean clothes on Sunday morning. He also instructs his overseers in the proper course for inflicting punishment.

Cocke's prominence as a planter, combined with his leadership in the colonization movement and his own doubts about slavery, made him a target of abolitionists who hoped he would free his slaves in order to set an example to other southern slaveholders. The Cocke Family Papers contain several items of correspondence between Cocke and persons involved in the abolitionist movement. A November 1839 letter from Cocke to abolitionist Gerritt Smith is answered by Smith in a letter dated December 11, 1840. In that letter, Smith appeals to Cocke's strong religious beliefs. He wrote: "Abolitionists are arrayed against slavery because they believe the relation between slaveholder and slave to be sinful.... Is American slavery sinful? You will not deny it. Indeed your letter virtually admits it...the immediate emancipation of your slaves is then your first duty" (Reel 34, Frame 0018). While Cocke was greatly troubled by the issue of slavery, he did not necessarily agree with Smith's argument. In one version of his last will and testament (September 4, 1817; Reel 9, Frame 1006), Cocke wrote that he would not free his slaves upon his death because he believed that in releasing his slaves to freedom without proper training, "the mass of human happiness would be diminished...." Cocke continued: "The general observation [is] that indiscriminate emancipation has not resulted in the happiness or well doing of but an inconsiderable minority of the individuals liberated...." Other versions of Cocke's last will and testament that include comments about slavery can be found at Reel 51, Frame 0848; Reel 55, Frame 0314; and Reel 57, Frame 0101. Another example of his correspondence with abolitionists is a November 1841 letter (Reel 34, Frame 0993) to the editor of the *Anti-Slavery Reporter* in which Cocke registers his protest against the paper's hostility to colonization.

The Cocke Family Papers also document many of the other causes central to Cocke's life. Many records relate to management of his plantations and his interest in agricultural practices and internal improvements. Scattered throughout the collection are inventories of slaves, stocks, and implements. An article on soils and manures (Reel 10, Frame 0866) reflects Cocke's advocacy of practices such as soil conservation, crop rotation, and the use of manures. Cocke also regularly received copies of the *Virginia and North Carolina Almanac*, which included astronomical and meteorological data useful to farmers. Several of these almanacs (Reel 29, Frame 0874 and Reel 40, Frame 0269) include Cocke's handwritten notes on agricultural production. Other information on agricultural production can be found in Cocke's day books and plantation journals in the bound volumes series of this collection.

Cocke's interest in temperance reform and education reform is also evident in the Cocke Family Papers. A July 31, 1834, note (Reel 27, Frame 0361) records his thoughts on temperance reform in Virginia. A May 2, 1836, letter (Reel 29, Frame 0240) from E. C. Delavan encloses resolutions passed at the United States Temperance Convention held in Philadelphia. A document dated May 1, 1830 (Reel 22, Frame 0139), describes the Fork Union Temperance Society and includes a list of members who were Cocke's slaves. Papers relating to education are also scattered throughout the collection. The most substantial records in this regard are the minutes of meetings of the University of Virginia Board of Visitors. Other documents related to education include an 1818 bill (Reel 10, Frame 0819) written by Thomas Jefferson for establishing a system of public education.

Military records from both the War of 1812 and the Civil War can also be found in the collection. Cocke served in the Virginia militia as a brigadier general during the War of 1812. These records begin at Frame 0499 of Reel 5 and continue intermittently through Frame 0636 of Reel 8. John Hartwell Cocke's son Philip St. George Cocke served for the Confederacy during the Civil War. An August 3, 1861, report describes the Battle of Manassas (Reel 54, Frame 0825). Two issues of the *Southern Almanac* from 1863 (Reel 56, Frames 0330 and 0359) contain reports on the Civil War.

The Cocke Family Papers conclude with thirty-two volumes of the diary of Louisa Maxwell Holmes Cocke, John Hartwell Cocke's second wife. Her diaries reveal intellectual and literary pursuits, her interaction with slaves, and general details of daily life at Upper Bremo. The diaries begin at Frame 0271 of Reel 63 and continue through the end of Reel 64. Correspondence from Louisa Maxwell Holmes Cocke is also scattered throughout the collection. The diaries of Lucy Cocke, the wife of John Hartwell Cocke's son Cary Charles Cocke, have been filed chronologically. Her diaries can be found at Reel 37, Frame 0750 (1844); Reel 44, Frame 0006 (February–December 1850); Reel 46, Frame 0224 (January 1851–April 1853); and Reel 47, Frame 0485 (1852–1887). This final diary includes comments on the Civil War.

N. B. A related collection among the holdings of the University of Virginia Library is Accession number 9513, the Bremo Recess Papers, 1790–1950, included in this edition beginning at Reel 65. Another related collection filmed by UPA is the Barraud Family Papers, 1779–1904, from the Earl Gregg Swem Library at the College of William and Mary. This collection is part of *Southern Women and Their Families in the 19th Century: Papers and Diaries, Series C: Holdings of the Earl Gregg Swem Library, The College of William and Mary in Virginia, Miscellaneous Collections, 1773–1938*. Cocke has also been the subject of several studies. The most detailed biography is Martin Boyd Coyner, "John Hartwell Cocke of Bremo: Agriculture and Slavery in the Ante-Bellum South" (Ph.D. dissertation, University of Virginia, 1961). Another important source is a book of letters from the Skipwith family to Cocke: Randall M. Miller, ed., *"Dear Master": Letters of a Slave Family* (Ithaca: Cornell University Press, 1978; reprint Athens: University of Georgia Press, 1990).

Bremo Recess Papers, Fluvanna County, Virginia; also Liberia, Accession Number 9513

Description of the Collection

The Bremo Recess Papers are arranged chronologically and span from ca. 1689 to 1865. The collection consists of business records, correspondence, newspaper clippings, and personal papers of the Cocke and Cabell families of Bremo Recess, located in Fluvanna County, Virginia.

Like the Cocke Family Papers, the Bremo Recess Papers cover a wide range of topics, including agriculture, internal improvements, and politics. Many documents in the collection cover African American history–related topics such as slavery, colonization, free blacks, and Reconstruction. One of the most interesting documents on the subject of slavery is a November 1848 advertisement reading: “Negroes wanted: The subscribers wish to hire for the year 1849, 150 ABLE BODIED NEGRO MEN to work on

their contract on the James River and Kanawha Canal” (Reel 70, Frame 0051). The advertisement mentions the prices willing to be paid for these hires and the commitment to provide clothes, food, and shelter for the workers.

The politics of slavery is covered in several items. A July 1848 speech in the House of Representatives by Thomas Flournoy of Virginia discusses slavery and the Wilmot Proviso and the positions of the Whig and Democratic parties on these two issues (Reel 70, Frame 0052). A speech by Abraham W. Venable of North Carolina, also delivered in the House, covers the power of Congress to legislate on slavery (Reel 70, Frame 0495). A February 14, 1857, article from the Richmond Whig newspaper discusses the Democratic Party’s stance on the issue of slavery (Reel 71, Frame 0097). There is also a February 28, 1853, newspaper clipping that defends the institution of slavery and argues that slavery produced some positive results for the United States (Reel 70, Frame 0222).

Several documents in the Bremon Recess Papers pertain to colonization. Letters from Matilda Richardson [Lomax] from Monrovia, Liberia (Reel 71, Frames 0108, 0109, and 0161), supplement the letters from her and other members of the Skipwith family that are included in the Cocke Family Papers. There is also a letter from J. H. Latrobe, president of the American Colonization Society, to Dr. J. Fouerda discussing colonization and slavery (Reel 70, Frame 0883). A letter in the *National Intelligencer* newspaper mentions a trip to Liberia aboard a ship able to hold sixty slaves (Reel 70, Frame 0109). An abstract of the 1857 annual report of the Colonization Society of Virginia is included at Frame 0100 of Reel 71. Other documents relating to African American history in this collection include a letter about passports for free blacks (Reel 70, Frame 0932) and a letter from Robert L. Dabney of Prince Edward County, Virginia, to Major General Oliver O. Howard discussing the enormous duties faced by Howard in his position as head of the Bureau of Freedmen, Refugees, and Abandoned Lands (Reel 71, Frame 0911).

The Bremon Recess Papers begin at Reel 65 and continue through the end of Reel 71.

N. B. A list of omissions from the Bremon Recess Papers is provided on Reel 71 at Frame 0998. Omissions consist of all items dated 1866 and after. A related collection among the holdings of the University of Virginia Library is Accession number 640, Cocke Family Papers, 1725–1939, included on the first sixty-four reels of this microfilm edition.
