### **ASPIRE** Details

The ASPIRE program provides free access to federal and state cases, codes, regulations, law reviews, *Shepard's*<sup>®</sup> Citation Service and Matthew Bender<sup>®</sup> treatises.

### **Eligible Students**

Rising 2Ls and 3Ls who pursue verifiable 501(c)(3) public interest work are eligible.

• Students may access the program until August 17, 2012

### **Eligible Graduates**

All December 2011 and spring 2012 graduates engaged in verifiable 501(c)(3) public interest work are eligible, including:

- Deferred fall associates
- Graduates searching for employment
- Graduates engaged in verifiable public interest work as a continuing profession

Access continues throughout public interest employment for December 2011 and 2012 graduates until September 1, 2013.

Graduates without an active LexisNexis ID should contact their Account Executive for application assistance.

## Additional Information

Students and graduates must work directly for a 501(c)(3) non-profit or charitable organization. Exclusions are:

- Government work (even if unpaid)\*
- Work for a law firm (even if it represents a non-profit organization)
- Solo practice (even if it encompasses non-profit work)
- Pro bono work that is neither non-profit nor charitable in nature
