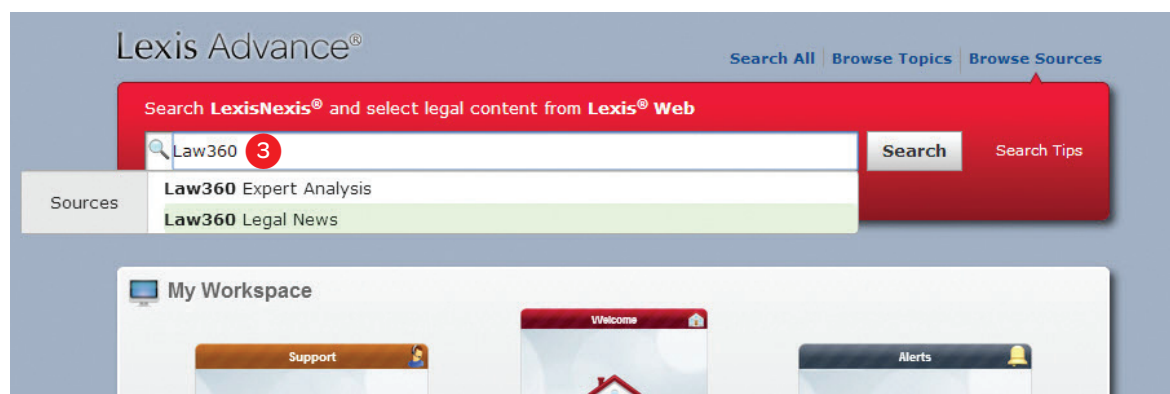

How to set up your daily Alert in Law360® on Lexis Advance.

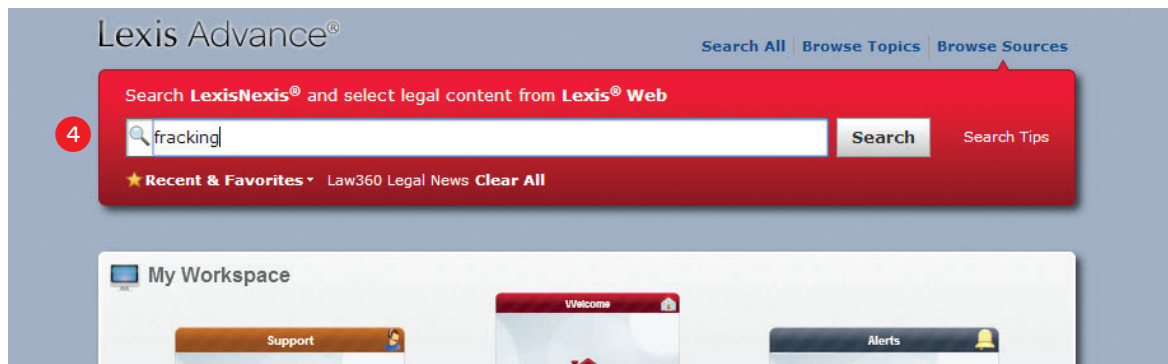
1. Go to www.lexisadvance.com.
2. Enter your Lexis Advance® ID & password.
3. In the red search box, enter Law360® (the word wheel will populate with sources, select Law360® Legal News)

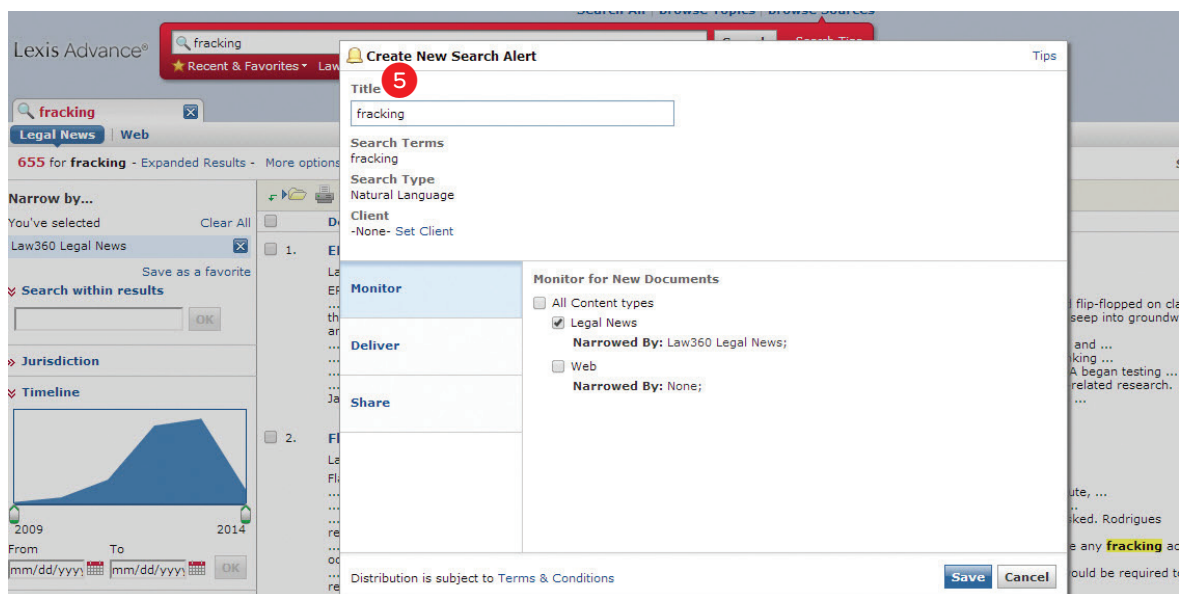


How to set up your daily Alert in Law360® (continued):

4. Enter your search (topic i.e. age discrimination or practice area i.e. bankruptcy)



5. Click the Alerts icon (yellow bell), top left in the Delivery options for your results.
-Under the Deliver tab, select Daily, Weekly or Monthly, duration and method of delivery. Click Save.
