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Study Reveals Continued Use of Social Media for Crime Investigations; Increased Focus on Crime Prevention

Despite widespread use by law enforcement, few agencies have formal processes, policies or dedicated staff in place.

LexisNexis® Risk Solutions announced the results of a comprehensive study focused on the use of social media by law enforcement for crime investigation and prevention. The study, a follow-up to one conducted in 2012, revealed that social media use remains high—eight out of 10 law enforcement professionals use it—with the most common use being for crime investigations (63%). More than half (51%) are using social media for crime prevention activities, with 67% agreeing social media is an effective tool for crime anticipation, both up from 2012.
