


Using LexisNexis Newsdesk™ Source Lists


Source Lists are easy to create, edit and utilize in LexisNexis Newsdesk™. They allow researchers the ability to create a list of favorite sources and restrict search results to those sources.

Here's an overview of the process:

To create a source list

Click on the Search tab, then click on the Source Lists subtab. Click on "Add a List."






Give the Source List a name.

Click on the "Source Index" tab, enter the name of a source in the search box and click enter.




Note that you may retrieve duplicate entries representing different versions of the same publication (licensed from LexisNexis®, scraped from the open web, separate blogs or other features).

To add the title, click on "Add/Remove" to the right of the title and check the box next to the name of the appropriate Source List. Continue this process to build your Source List.



To use the Source List


Click on the "Search" tab and open the Advanced pull down in the lower right hand corner below the search box. Click on the "Source Lists" tab, and drag the Source List to the "Selected Source Lists" column to the right.




Enter your search terms in the search box. Your results will be limited to the sources contained in your Source List.

To edit the Source List


First, you need to open the existing source list.






Then identify the title you want to delete (in the example below, "The Orange County Register").

Simply click on the trash can icon on the right hand side to delete the unwanted source.





Note that you have other actions available within the Source Lists, depending upon whether or not you created the lists.



If it is a LexisNexis Newsdesk™ created source list – as indicated by the locked icon to the left of the source list title— your only choice is to clone it, which would then give you the ability to add or delete sources included in the original list. Source lists that you've created are able to be shared, renamed, cloned or deleted.
