Saving your search for automatic updates is easy

Just run your search as you normally would. (Talk to your account representative or LexisNexis Customer Support if you need help developing your search request.) Once you've reviewed your results and are happy with them, click on **Save as ECLIPSE**.

Then just complete the form shown at right. Have your updates delivered to you every day, every business day, or each week or each month on the day you choose. Or access your updates online.

E-mail notification

Have an e-mail note sent to you, letting you know that there are updated results available. The note will include a URL to which you can link to display your results. This option lets you use the FOCUS™ feature within your results to zero in on specific terms. You can also change the display format for easier viewing.

E-mail delivery

Have your results sent directly to your e-mail address in whatever display format you choose. Print them or cut and paste them into your word-processing program as need be.

ECLIPSE search examples

Monitor cases decided in your state dealing with a particular topic. For example, if you're in Illinois and interested in personal injury cases involving a failure to warn about a drug's potentially harmful side effects, you might set up a search like this and have it run weekly:

SOURCE: Legal tab > Area of Law - By Topic > Torts > Cases > Personal Injury > IL Personal Injury Cases

SEARCH: *fail! /5 warn! /50 drug /10 harm! OR injur! OR adverse*

Get a list of current articles from a newsletter in your specialty area. For example, say your firm specializes in intellectual property law. You might set up a search like this and have it run daily:

SOURCE: Legal tab > Secondary Legal > Mealey Publications > Intellectual Property: Mealey's Combined Reports

SEARCH: *date aft 2/2003*

Track mentions of your firm or one of your clients in the news. You might set up a search like one of these and have it run monthly:

SOURCE: News tab > News Group File, Most Recent 90 Days

SEARCH:* *"cage & fish"*

OR

SEARCH:* *behemoth electronics*
