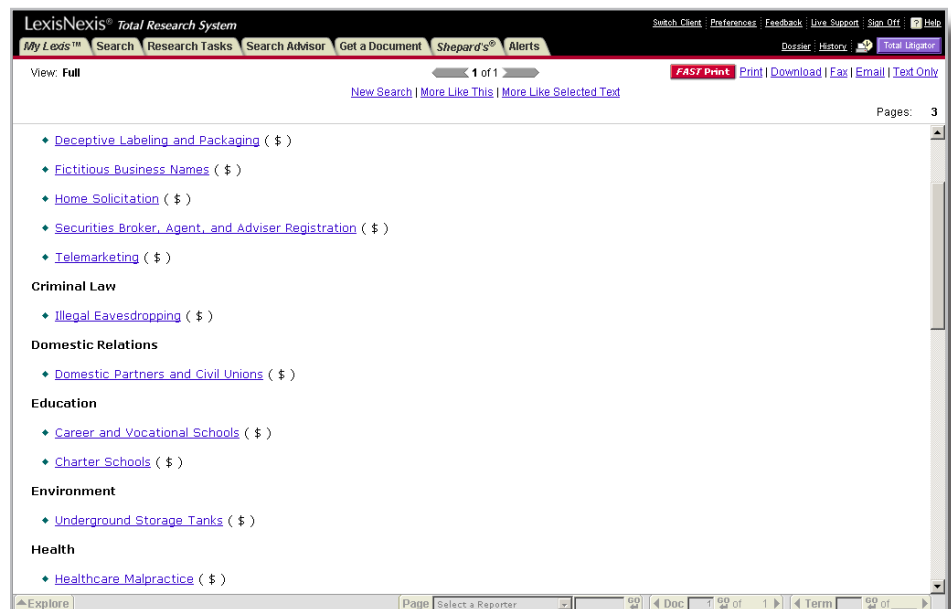


Compare legislation and regulations on a specific topic ... From all 50 states ... *with a single mouse click*

The results of your 50 State Survey request will display in a simple, easy-to-read Excel® spreadsheet. States are listed alphabetically with separate sections for statutes and regulations. If you want to view the full text of a specific section, simply click on the section cite.

(Note: you must have access to Microsoft Excel to display survey results.)

If you've saved your LexisNexis® ID, you'll go straight to the document. If not, you'll be prompted to enter your ID and password. This will take you into *lexis.com*® where you can review the results.

Cal Bus & Prof Code § 17900 (2007)

§ 17900. "Fictitious business name"

(a) As used in this chapter, "fictitious business name" means:

(1) In the case of an individual, a name that does not include the surname of the individual or a name that suggests the existence of additional owners.
