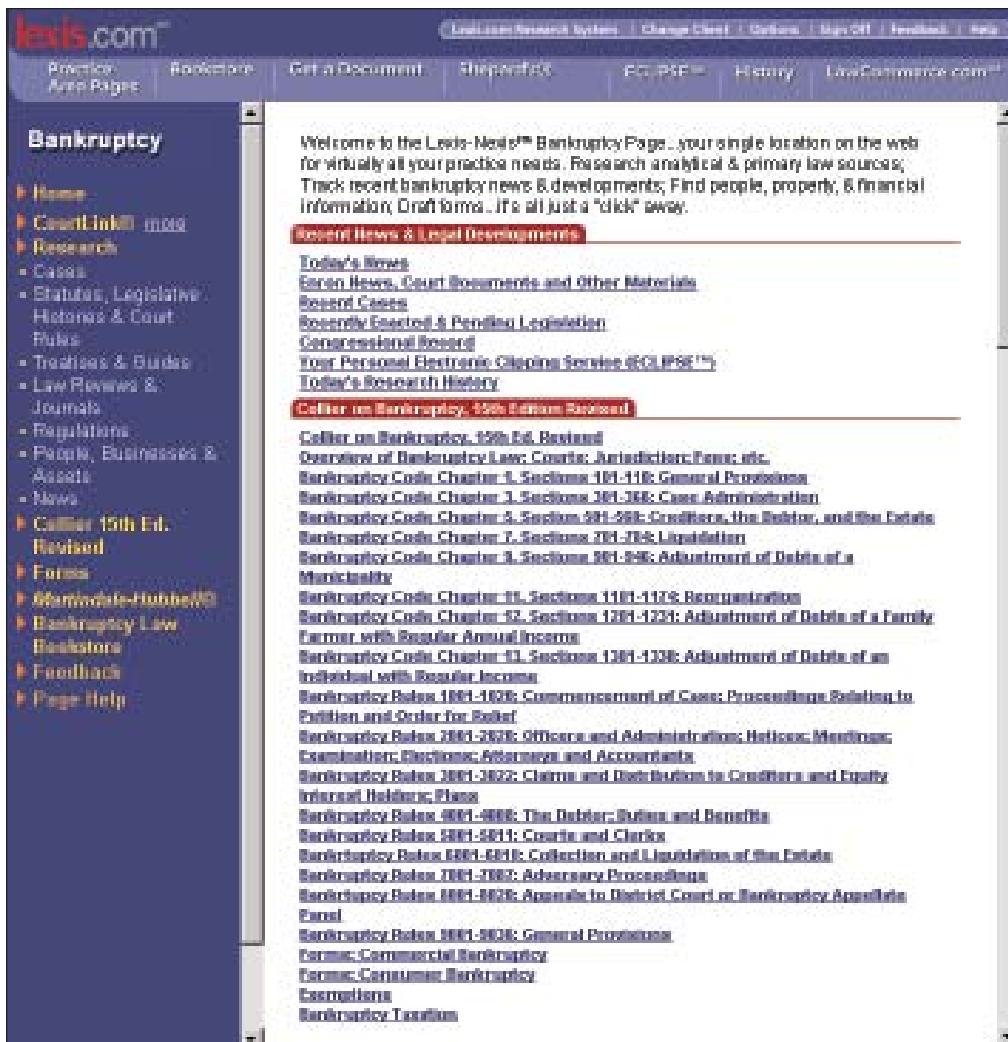
The LexisNexis Bankruptcy Page offers the bankruptcy sources you use the most, including cases,

Case Law

By Citation –

1. Select CASES
2. Go to **Option 1: Get or Shepardize® a Case**
3. Enter the citation, e.g.,
ENTER: *138 led2d 148*
4. Click Get A Case then GO

By Party, Judge's or Attorney's name(s) –

1. Select CASES
2. Go to **Option 2: Research Bankruptcy Case Law**
3. Click **Search Popular Segments**
4. Enter name in appropriate box, e.g., ENTER: *goodman*
5. Click GO

By Topic, e.g., cases that discuss reaffirmation of credit-card debt:

1. Select CASES
2. Go to **Option 2: Research Bankruptcy Case Law**
3. Select **Bankruptcy Court Decisions**
4. Click **Search Any Terms**
5. Enter your search terms, e.g.,
SEARCH: *reaffirm! W/10 credit card*
6. Click GO

U.S. Court Rules

By Rule Number –

1. Select STATUTES, LEGISLATIVE HISTORIES & COURT RULES
2. Go to **Option 2: Quick Searches – Get a Rule**
3. Select **Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure**
4. ENTER: *2016*
5. Click GO

By Topic, e.g., compensation for expenses, without searching in the annotations:

1. Select STATUTES, LEGISLATIVE HISTORIES & COURT RULES
2. Go to **Option 9: Search Statutes, Legislation & Rules By Source**
3. Click **USCS Bankruptcy Rules & Official Bankruptcy Forms**
4. SEARCH: *unanno(compensat! OR reimburs! W/10 expense)*
5. Click SEARCH

Local Court Rules

By Topic –

1. Select STATUTES, LEGISLATIVE HISTORIES & COURT RULES
2. Go to **Option 5: Search a Specific Local Court Rule**
3. Choose a specific **jurisdiction**, e.g., New York
4. Enter your search terms, e.g.,
SEARCH: *attorney W/5 fee*
5. Click GO

State Exemption Law

By Topic:

1. Select STATUTES, LEGISLATIVE HISTORIES & COURT RULES
2. Go to **Option 8: Search a Specific State Exemption Law**
3. Select the **state**, e.g., Ohio;
SEARCH: *residence*
4. Click GO

Statutes

By Citation –

1. Select STATUTES, LEGISLATIVE HISTORIES & COURT RULES
2. Go to **Option 1: Quick Searches – Get a Statute**
3. Enter the citation, e.g.,
ENTER: *11 uscs 503*
4. Click GO

By Topic, e.g., U.S. statutes concerning requirements for a trustee in assuming or rejecting an executable contract:

1. Select STATUTES, LEGISLATIVE HISTORIES & COURT RULES
2. Go to **Option 4: Search a Specific Title of the USCS**
3. Select **All USCS Titles**
4. SEARCH: *trustee W/20 assum! OR reject! W/20 execut! W/5 contract!*
5. Click GO

Legislation

By Congressional Bill Number, i.e., to find the full-text bill, e.g., H.R. 333:

1. Select STATUTES, LEGISLATIVE HISTORIES & COURT RULES
2. Go to **Option 6: Get Full Text Bill & Tracking Reports By Number**
3. Choose the **Bill Text** box
4. ENTER: *333*
5. Click GO

To find the **bill-tracking report** for H.R. 333:

1. Select STATUTES, LEGISLATIVE HISTORIES & COURT RULES
2. Go to **Option 6: Get Full Text Bill & Tracking Reports By Number**
3. Choose the **Bill Tracking** box
4. ENTER: **333**
5. Click GO

Switch between the full-text bill and its bill-tracking report easily by using the links included in both.

By Congressional Committee Reports on H.R. 333, *Bankruptcy Abuse Prevention and Consumer Protection Act of 2001*, leave the Bankruptcy Page and:

1. Choose **lexis.com® Research System** tab
2. PATH: **Legislation & Politics > U.S. Congress > Committee Reports**
3. SEARCH: **title (bankruptcy abuse)**

To return to the Bankruptcy Page, follow the directions on page one.

By Legislative Histories, e.g., to research the issue of production payments in the legislative history of the *Bankruptcy Reform Act of 1994*:

1. Select STATUTES, LEGISLATIVE HISTORIES & COURT RULES
2. Go to **Option 7: Search Legislative History By Source**
3. Choose **Bankruptcy Reform Act of 1994**
4. SEARCH: **production payments**

Debtor/Creditor Information

By Debtor's Name (person or business); find **UCC filings** from all 50 states:

1. Select PEOPLE, BUSINESSES & ASSETS
2. Go to **Option 1: Quick Searches – Get Public Record**
3. Enter name in **UCC Filings** box, e.g.,
*SEARCH: **go for broke sporting**

By Debtor's Name (person or business); find **bankruptcy court filings** from all 50 states:

1. Select PEOPLE, BUSINESSES & ASSETS
2. Go to **Option 1: Quick Searches – Get Public Record**
3. Enter name in **Bankruptcy Filings** box, e.g.,
*SEARCH: **go for broke sporting**

By Debtor's Name (person or business); find **real-estate assets** from 46 states:

1. Select PEOPLE, BUSINESSES & ASSETS
2. Go to **Option 2: Search Public Records By Source**
3. PATH: **Real Property Records > Combined Deed Transfers, Tax Assessor Records and Mortgage Records**. Click **NEW SEARCH**
4. *SEARCH: **name(rollinW/3 nW/3 holmes)**

By Debtor's Name (person or business); find out if your client has a **judgment or lien** against him in a state:

1. Select PEOPLE, BUSINESSES & ASSETS
2. Go to **Option 2: Search Public Records By Source**
3. PATH: **Judgments & Liens > Combined Judgments & Liens > Select a State**. Click **NEW SEARCH**
4. *SEARCH: **name(rollinW/3 nW/3 holmes)**

Collier on Bankruptcy®, 15th Edition Revised

By Treatise Table of Contents if you know where to find a topic, e.g., the *U.S. Bankruptcy Code* section regarding cross-border cases,

1. Select COLLIER 15th ED. REVISED
2. PATH: **Bankruptcy Code Chapter 3. Sections 301-366 Case Administration > Chapter 304: Cases Ancillary to Foreign Proceedings**

To return to the table of contents after reviewing a full-text section, click [TOC](#).

By Topic, e.g., cross-border cases:

1. Select COLLIER 15th ED. REVISED
2. Go to **Option 1: Select a Collier's Link**
3. Choose **Collier on Bankruptcy, 15th Ed. Revised**
4. SEARCH: **cross border**

3. PATH: **Bankruptcy Filings > Combined Bankruptcy Filings**
4. *SEARCH: *abcdoughnut*

By Topic, e.g., to find details on the status of a particular debtor using Bankruptcy DataSource company profiles, reorganization plans and other news:

1. Select PEOPLE, BUSINESSES & ASSETS
2. Go to **Option 2: Search Public Records By Source**
3. Select **Bankruptcy DataSource**
4. *SEARCH: *abcdoughnut*

By Topic, e.g., to review summaries of reorganization plans filed for debtors in the casino industry:

1. Select PEOPLE, BUSINESSES & ASSETS
2. Go to **Option 2: Search Public Records By Source**
3. Select **Bankruptcy DataSource**
4. SEARCH: *publication(plan summary) AND casino*

Company Information

By Topic, e.g., to find information on a business because you represent one of its creditors:

1. Select PEOPLE, BUSINESSES & ASSETS
2. Go to **Option 2: Search Public Records By Source**
3. PATH: **Business & Corporation Information > Standard & Poor's Register of Corporations**
4. *SEARCH: *abcdoughnut*

By Subject, e.g., to follow developments and trends on personal services contracts:

1. Select NEWS
2. Choose **Option 2: Search News by Source**
3. Select **BNA Bankruptcy Law Daily**
4. SEARCH: *personal services*

News

By Subject, e.g., recent news on bankruptcy reform legislation:

1. Select NEWS
2. Choose **Option 1: Quick Searches – Get a News Story or Article**
3. Select a **Date Restrictor: Previous Month**
4. SEARCH: *bankrupt! W/5 reform! W/5 bill OR law OR legislat! OR act*
