1. Enter <http://www.lexis.com/companyanalyzer> and bookmark this site for easy reference.
2. Enter your LexisNexis ID and password and a client name to identify this session.
3. Enter a company name in the Company Name box. Tip: Avoid using terms like “Inc” or “Corp.”
4. Choose the dates you would like to search (optional) by using the pull-down menu or by entering dates in the From and To boxes.
5. The default setting is 20 documents per source, but you can change this to any number you want, or click All to retrieve all documents for each source.
6. Choose the sources you want to search.
 - A. Choose *All LexisNexis Company Analyzer Sources* to search all available sources.
 - B. Choose *Select Sources* to display a list of sources that can be searched individually or combined according to your needs.
 - C. Choose *Favorite Source Sets* to select a set of sources you previously saved or to create a new set of favorite sources.
 - D. Click *Next* to display the Summary screen
7. The Summary screen displays the information you entered on the Start Page, as well as the sources you selected. Before running your search, you may want to click *Save Selection*. The source selection will then be saved for the next time you access this client..
8. Click *Search* to run your search.

9. A list of documents found by your search will display. Check the boxes next to the documents you want to include in your final report and click **Generate Report**.
10. To display the documents you have retrieved in a format that can be printed or saved, click the **Print/Save Format** button. This will display the full text of the reports you have selected in another window so they can be either printed or saved. Clicking the button does not automatically save or print your results.
11. To save your results, select **File** from your browser toolbar and click **Save As**. Select the drive, directory, and file name, then click **Save**. This will save your results in html format so they can be viewed in your browser later.
12. To print your results, select **File** from your browser toolbar and click **Print** or use the function keys “Cntl+P” to display the Print dialog box. Select the printer you want to use and click **OK**. This will deliver the text of the documents you were viewing to the printer you have selected.
13. To return to LexisNexis Company Analyzer, return to the browser window in which LexisNexis Company Analyzer is running. You can:
 - Click the **Main** button at the top of the screen to run another search.
 - Click **Sign-Off** to exit the LexisNexis Company Analyzer service.
