- *Emerging Markets Online*, its daily internet-based service offering same-day comment and interpretation of key financial and economic developments;
- *Emerging Markets Monitor*, a 20-page weekly brief on bonds, equities and foreign exchange;
- *Regional Monthly Monitors*, 17 publications that provide political risk assessment and macroeconomic analysis and forecasts; and
- *Quarterly Country Forecast Reports*, 21 editions that providing data, analysis and forecasts over a 3-year horizon.

- *Benelux*: Five regional dailies in the Netherlands, which are published by Wegener – each paper has multiple editions depending on the city or village; also available is *Fusie en Overname*, a monthly with takeover and merger news in the Netherlands; and finally, a popular Benelux daily called *Het Volk*, which covers regional and international news with a social dimension.

- *France:* Group Expansion publications include *L'Express*, a weekly general news magazine, and *Lire*, a weekly literary magazine; also available are *La Tribune.fr*, the Web version of France's daily economic and financial newspaper, and *Le Telegramme*, the daily newspaper of the Brittany region (Available in French).
- *Germany:* *Börsen-Zeitung*, the leading German financial daily, which is considered to be the official German stock market publication.
- *Spain:* *El Mundo*; Spain's second largest daily newspaper; the Spanish-language content from Deutsche Presse-Agentur, a German-owned news wire service covering politics and economics with Spanish-speaking correspondents in all Latin American capitals, as well as major U.S. and European cities (Spanish language).
- *Switzerland:* *PME Magazine*, published by Swiss publisher HandelsZeitung, is a French-language monthly focused on small business.
- *United Kingdom:* *Sunday Tribune*, Ireland's leading weekly broadsheet; *Yorkshire Post*, England's influential daily in publication for 250 years; 15 of Regional Independent Media's daily newspapers.

Canada

- *Southam Publications Inc.:* Ten well-respected Southam Publications now available on LexisNexis services cover Canada from the East (*The Halifax Daily News* and *St. John's Telegram*) to the West (*Edmonton Journal* and *The Vancouver Province*).

- *Australia:* Through media giant **John Fairfax Holdings Limited**, LexisNexis services include major metropolitan dailies e.g., *The Sydney Morning Herald*, *The (Melbourne) Age*, and *The Sun-Herald*; business media (e.g., *The Australian Financial Review*, a daily, and the *Business Review Weekly*); and financial/investment magazines, and regional papers.
- *New Zealand:* *Dominion Post*, a leading New Zealand general news daily published by Wellington Newspaper Ltd.

PRLine and CompanyNews – Two Ubiquis Group services

- *PRLine*: Launched in 1998 as the first online investor relations service for listed companies in France, PRLine now also covers the Belgian, Dutch, Spanish, Italian and English markets. Data includes financial statistics, as well as annual reports, letters to shareholders and analyst presentations. Sources include press agencies, financial institutions, public relations agencies, financial information providers and ISPs. (Available in English, French, Dutch, Spanish and Italian languages.)
- *CompanyNews*: A subsidiary of Agence France Presse, Agefi and Ubiquis, CompanyNews Group is the leading French distributor of news, analysis and financial information on nearly 5,000 French and non-French companies. LexisNexis services now include information on U.S. and German companies in this dataset. (Available in French.)

Pressi.com: Press Information Worldwide

Pressi.com – a leading worldwide corporate news agency founded in 1998 by a Finnish-based company, Net Release Global Oy – publishes and delivers company news releases, photos and multimedia. (Available in English, Swedish and Finnish languages.)

Japan Corporate News Network

The JCN Network – founded in 1999 by investment bankers and journalists – reports in English on Japan's business, financial and technology news. Included are English versions of large companies' press releases; articles on smaller technology, biotechnology and alternative energy companies; and earnings reports.

World Market Share Reporter

Published by **Gale Research Inc.**, this compilation of reported world market share data and rankings on companies, products and services includes approximately 1,670 entries covering 360 geographic locations.

Academic and professional management journals: Emerald (MCB University Press)

Emerald, the new trading name for MCB University Press, is the leading international publisher of academic and professional management literature and a globally recognized source of online management information. MCB University Press Ltd is a 35-year-old privately owned, independent publisher in the United Kingdom. LexisNexis added more than four dozen of its country-specific, pan-European and international journals on topics such as food, marketing, technology, systems management, sociology, economics, medicine and history

EuropeMedia, a four-year-old, pan-European daily news service, covers the Internet, technology, telecoms, cable and satellite, including business developments as well as government policy, online publishing and new media. Also available are *TV Meets the Web* and *Wireless News*, two other high-tech dailies by the parent company, M2 Communications, which is an international publisher and data provider based in Coventry, England.

German- and Dutch-language trade publications

- **Medien Aktuell**: A biweekly magazine covering the media industry including television, radio, multimedia, Internet, advertising and public relations. (Available in German)
- Three monthly magazines by **Deutscher Fachverlag GmbH** covering the international meat industry, agriculture and marketing & advertising respectively. (Available in German.)
- Eight **Behrs Verlag** ("*Wer und Was...*" or "*Who and What...*") directories, which cover industries such as specific food and beverage verticals; pharmaceuticals; and hygiene. (Available in German.)
- Two Benelux trades: A weekly travel journal (*Reisrevue*) and a monthly magazine for entrepreneurs and small business owners (*Bizz*). (Available in Dutch.)

African energy and mining: Indigo Publications

LexisNexis has added two Africa-focused, bimonthly trade journals by Indigo Publications, launched in 1981 with a focus on hard-to-find confidential news for a specialized readership: *Africa Energy Intelligence*, the first publication on oil, gas and electricity in Africa, and *Africa Mining Intelligence*, the only publication devoted entirely to African mining. (Available in English, French.)
