



Results Clustering

Results clustering technology provides an instant, multi-faceted analysis of the distribution of hits in each results set, allowing users to filter results and go directly to relevant information. After running a search in LexisNexis Academic, and obtaining results that contain more than one hit, results are displayed similar to the screen shown below.

Spreadsheet Download for News Results

Each spreadsheet will automatically include data from the Date, Publication, Headline, Byline, Dateline, Section, and Length segments. Optional segments that may be selected are Company, Organization, Geography, Subject, HLead, Person, Industry and Ticker.
