

Follow the steps below to borrow and download an eBook from LexisNexis[®] Digital Library to your desktop or laptop. For most digital libraries, choose from three platforms—OverDrive Read[™] (in-browser reading), ePub or Kindle[®] (read on your e-reader device or app). To access full functionality of the LexisNexis[®] Digital Library site, you will need to have one of the following browsers installed: Internet Explorer[®] 10, Google Chrome[™], Apple[®] Safari[®] or Mozilla Firefox[®].







1. Sign in with your organization-issued credentials.

2. Search by title name, author, subject or keyword; or browse the content listing and select a publication.

Clicking the **Menu** function will display categories by practice area, jurisdiction and featured collections.

Click the **Borrow** button for available options in your Bookshelf.

More information about the title is available in the drop-down categories below the description.

Click the **Save to List** function to place the title in your bookshelf list and return later to borrow it. Use this feature to easily locate titles you use most often. Click the **Share** feature to email a direct link to an eBook to another user within your digital library collection.

3. Click the **Borrow** button for available options in your Bookshelf.

Reading options may vary based on your organization's e-reading software decisions. For most digital libraries, three options are available: Amazon® Kindle®, ePub or OverDrive® Read™.

Click Download to obtain a Kindle® (if available) or ePub version.

Clicking the Read button launches OverDrive® Read[™] to read in your Web browser. Ensure you have a modern browser; Internet Explorer® 10, Google Chrome[™], Apple® Safari® or Mozilla Firefox®.



Downloading eBooks for Kindle

Click on the Download selection to display available options. If a Kindle version is available it will display as a choice.

Click **Kindle Book** to borrow from your digital library via Amazon[®]. An active Amazon account is required for individual users.

Downloading eBooks for ePub e-readers

Click **ePub eBook** to borrow from your digital library to read on your installed e-reader. Then click **Confirm & Download**. Your eBook will launch in the e-reader.

Note: Install your e-reader prior to downloading. Adobe[®] Digital Editions is popular for desktop/laptop reading for both PC and Mac[®]. An active Adobe ID is required via a quick registration as part of the installation process.
