**Navigate search terms seamlessly from one document to the next**. Select a search term or phrase from the **Navigate all terms** box at the top of your full-text document. Then use the **Previous** or **Next** arrow next to the box to navigate. When you reach the last occurrence of a term in your full-text document, click the **Next** arrow and move to the **first occurrence in the succeeding document**. (Click the **Previous** arrow and move from the first occurrence in a document to the last occurrence in the preceding document.)
