

The Top 10 Most Important Things YOU Need to Know About Lexis® Advance....In 5 Minutes or Less

Lexis® Advance is so intuitive and easy to use that you may not need training. This document highlights 10 key features that you will want to know about to make your Lexis Advance experience even better!

Feature	How it Benefits You
1. Red Search Box	A “Google-like” search allows you to obtain the right results faster and easier without selecting a specific source.
2. Pre and Post Search Filters	Allows you to filter answer sets according to content, jurisdiction, and/or practice area or topic, dramatically improving your search time and results. Use post-search filters to further narrow your results and drive to the information you need.
3. My Workspace is “home base”	Access, organize and manage your legal research in one place through a visual and intuitive carousel interface. Navigate quickly around the product and quickly access Alerts, Work Folders and History.
4. Legal Issue Trail	<p>The Legal Issue Trail (LIT) is a patented tool on Lexis Advance that helps you find connections between cases on a specific point of law level that may not have otherwise been made. When you “activate passages,” Lexis Advance puts a perforated box around each of the specific points of law or legal issues identified in the specific case. As a user, you now have the ability to review the case and once you find a point of law that is directly “on point” with what you are researching, you can click inside that perforated box (which contains the actual sentence or paragraph that covers the point of law) to get to a trail of related cases.</p> <p>The trail provides links to cases that your case cites for the exact same point of law, as well as other cases that cite to your case for the exact same point of law.</p>
5. Options for Selected Text (Green +)	When you highlight any text in Lexis Advance, a green box and plus sign (+) appears. This feature allows you to save that highlighted text into a work folder, run another search using that selected text, or copy that cite and import it into your brief.
6. Shepard’s + Shepard’s Graphical	<p><i>Shepard’s</i> – validate whether cases and statutes are still good law.</p> <p><i>Shepard’s</i> Graphical – just click on the Citing Decisions tab to see the history of the citing decisions in an easy visual grid or map format.</p>
7. Transparent Pricing	You can search all available content but will only be charged a fee if you access (i.e. open) documents that are outside of your subscription. In addition, the results list clearly shows which documents is a part of your subscription and which ones can be purchased separately.
8. Saving to and accessing a Work Folder	Store and re-use results right where you are working or send those results to colleagues.
9. “Search Within Results”	Search for specific results within your results to quickly get to the most important issues.
10. History is now 90 days!	Avoid re-doing a search by displaying previous searches, now for up to 90 days!
