2.2 Designed for Practicality

Every obligation in our compliance registers is structured the same way so you can quickly locate the information you need.

- → **Practical guidance** notes explains what it means to be compliant and how to get there

Complying with awards

Description questional

Does the organisation have processes and procedures to ensure compliance with the terms of any modern award that applies to its employees?

Practical guidance

Modern awards apply to the majority of workers in Australia, and specify minimum conditions of employment including wages and working hours in a particular industry or occupation. An organisation must be aware of any modern award that applies to its employees, and ensure that it is compliant with the terms of the award.

Certain terms are mandatory in modern awards, including terms detailing:

- → Dispute resolution procedures for disputes relating to an award or the National Employment Standards
- → Consultation requirements when an organisation is seeking to vary an employee's ordinary working hours
- → The process for entering into an "individual flexibility arrangement", where the application of certain terms of an award is varied to suit the needs of the organisation and an individual employee

Ordinary working hours

All organisations must be prepared to comply with the above terms in the relevant award.

Awards may also cover a range of other matters, including:

- → Minimum wages, bonuses, overtime and penalty rates
- → Leave and flexible working arrangements
- → Types of worker (e.g. full-time, part-time, casual, etc.)
- → Work arrangements such as rostering and rest breaks

Staff who have responsibility for managing employees and their terms and conditions (e.g. rostering, payroll) should receive training on the rights and responsibilities detailed in a relevant award.

The organisation must also ensure it keeps up-to-date with any changes to an award (e.g. to the minimum pay rates).

Remedial action

Train relevant staff on their rights and responsibilities under any relevant modern award, and ensure the award is complied with.

Consequence

Organisations may face a range of consequences depending on the nature of the breach of employment laws, including:

- → Penaltied to a maximum of \$12,600 per contravention for individuals (including unincorporated businesses) and \$63,000 per contravention for corporations (Fair Work Act 2009 (Cth) Ch 4 Pt 4-1). A serious contravention (the person knows they were contravening their obligation, or the contravention was part of a systematic pattern of behaviour) can result in a maximum penalty of \$126,000 for some offences
- → Injunctions
- ightarrow Orders for compensation for unpaid entitlements
- → Infringement and compliance notices issued by the Fair Work Ombudsman





Q: This looks complex to set up and we don't have IT support readily available. How can I access the content?

A: If you don't already have existing software, we can work with one of our partners to provide a full package of content and workflow software to meet your existing and future needs. Alternatively, we can provide you with content via our Online Portal.

Q: I have existing Compliance software. How do you input your content into my system?

A: We do this through an API (application programming interface). An API allows two different applications to "shake hands" with each other. In our case, an API allows the Content Management System (CMS) we use to store our content to talk with your existing software, and therefore allows the transfer of content accordingly.

Q: What is the difference between core modules and industry modules?

A: Core Modules cover legal obligations and actions required of most Australian organisations. These include: Anti-Bribery and Corruption; Competition and Consumer; Corporations; Data Protection & Privacy; Employment; Environment; Tax; WHS.

Industry modules include Compliance modules that are industry-specific, including Aged Care; General Insurance and Asset Management.

Q. How is each register structured?

A. The content in registers is structured to make it easy to find what you're looking for, and work out what you need to do.

Overview – This defines the scope of the module and lists the core obligations.

Core Obligations – Identifies a high-level view of the organisation's legal obligations for the area covered by the module. This is the basis for navigating efficiently through the module.

Sub Obligations – The sub-obligations are the individual operational obligations required to meet the core obligation.

Tools – The tools include checklists, policy templates, precedents, process flowcharts and links (usually hyperlinks to web pages). Alerts – There are 3 forms of alert being information only, action required and news.
