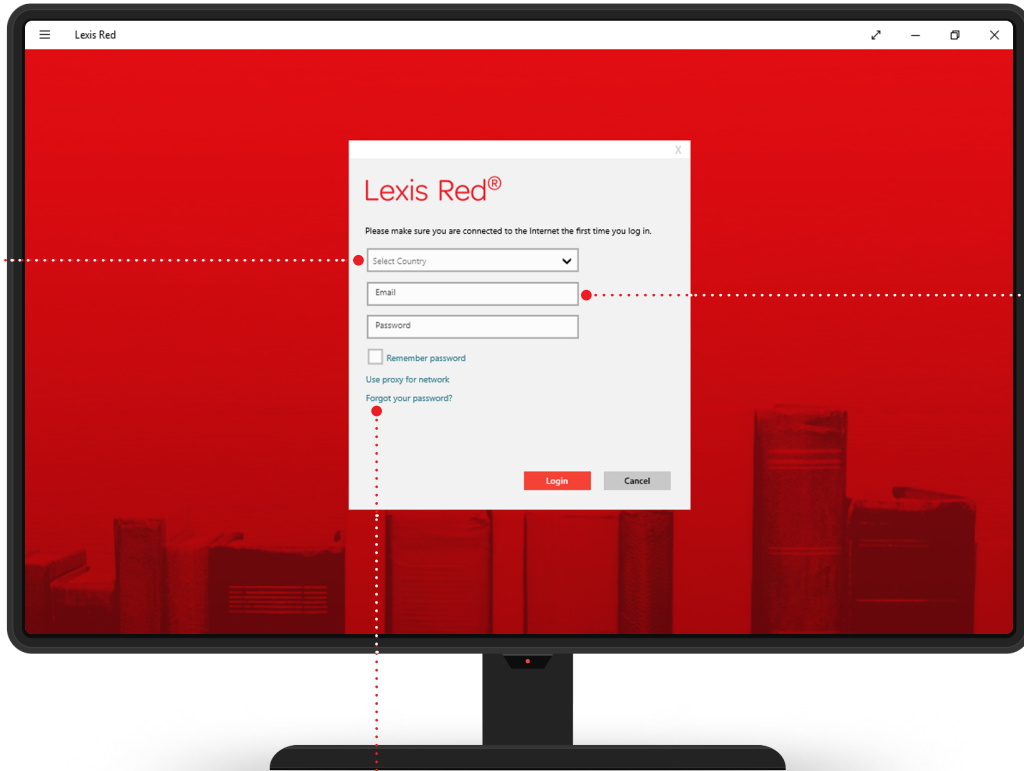

Downloading Lexis Red

Open the Microsoft Store, search for 'Lexis Red' and select the  app. Click  to download and install Lexis Red.

Logging in to Lexis Red

Select your country.



Enter your **login email** and **password**. If this is your first time logging in, please refer to your welcome email for login details.

Reset your password.

Type a partial or full title name to see relevant publications instantly.

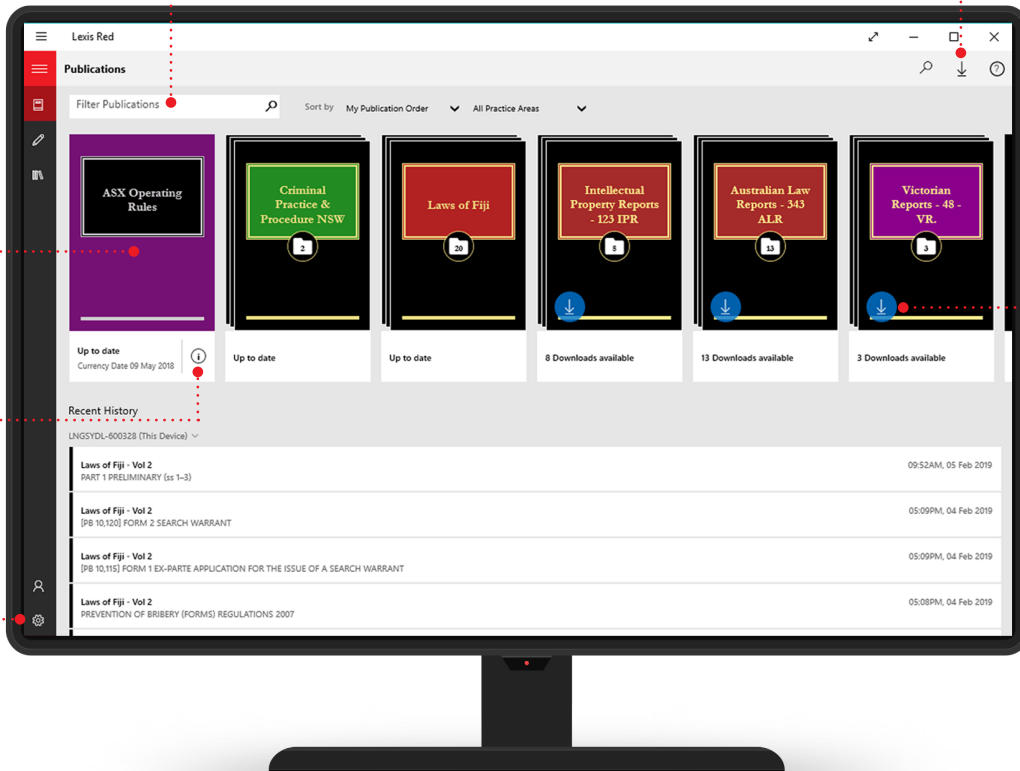
Click the **front cover** to open a publication.

Click to view the automatic updates option.

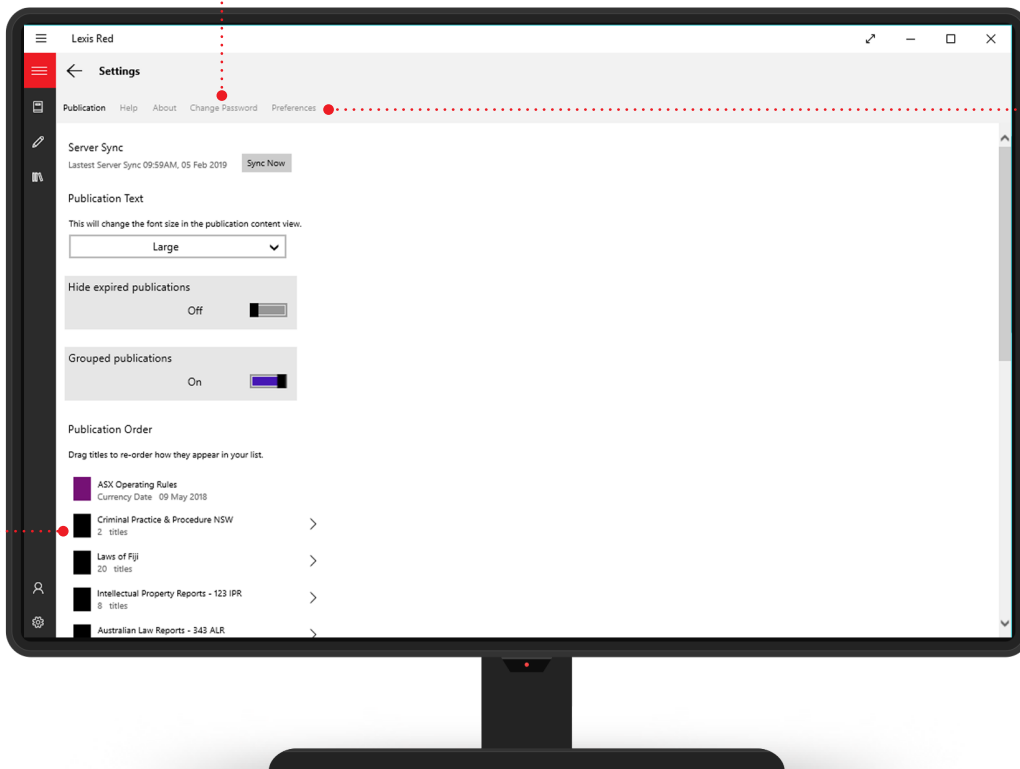
Click the **Download** icon to download the publication to your device.

NOTE: Deleting a highlight will also delete any associated tagging or notes.



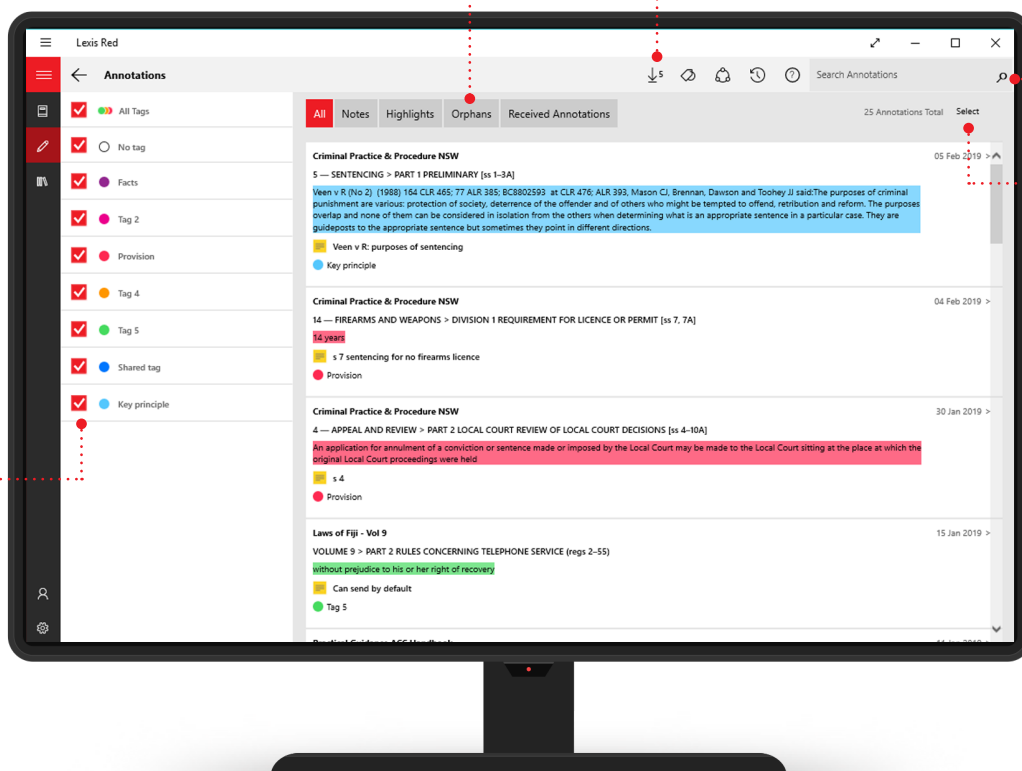
Orphans are notes that have been removed by content updates.
