Is the entity required, as mandated by law or by volunteering, to submit a modern slavery statement within the required timeframe and according to the mandatory criteria?

Has the entity set up governance policies to ensure identification, assessment and management of modern slavery risks in its business operations and supply chains on an ongoing basis?
