#### Navigation and Ease-of- Use Highlights

**Improved content classification and refined checkout period options:** This functionality gives administrators the ability to set lending periods based on the physical format type of a given title, allowing for more optimal circulation. A treatise or study aid, for example, can now be set with a shorter lending period compared to a desk book which could be checked out for as long as a year. The new classifications and lending periods are:
