

Introduction to: Coursebook Support Communities

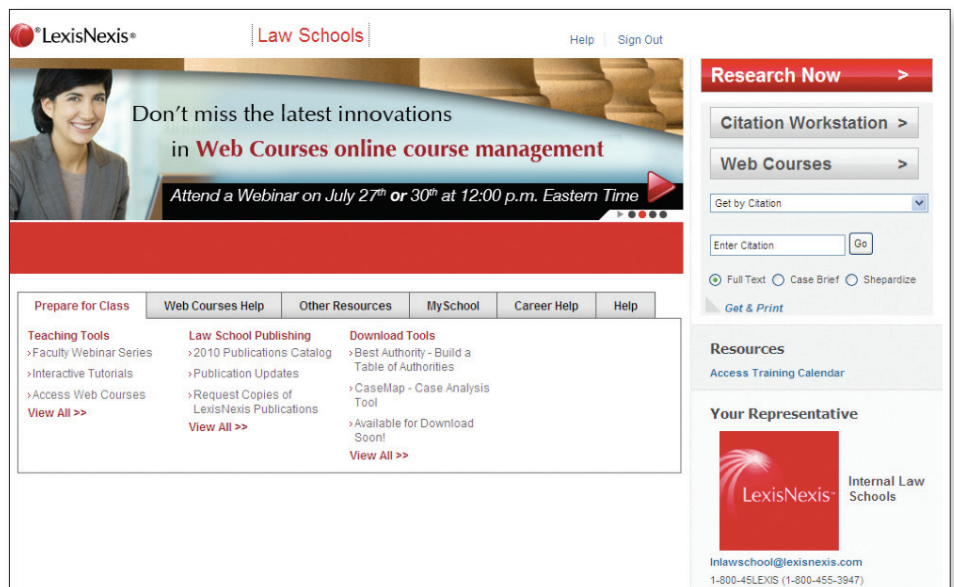

All CSCs will include annual supplements as well as the coursebook teacher's manual. And, as they are further developed each semester, each CSC will also:



- Offer a forum for authors and adopters enrolled in the course to contribute additional materials relevant to the coursebook and subject matter, including PowerPoint® slides, syllabi, teaching notes, podcasts and videos;
- Provide an opportunity for authors, adopters and potential adopters to collaborate on different ways to teach from the coursebook and to use the materials in the book in the classroom;
- Include author and adopter comments on cases, statutes and current events; and
- Allow for cases and statutes highlighted and discussed in the book to be updated throughout the semester.

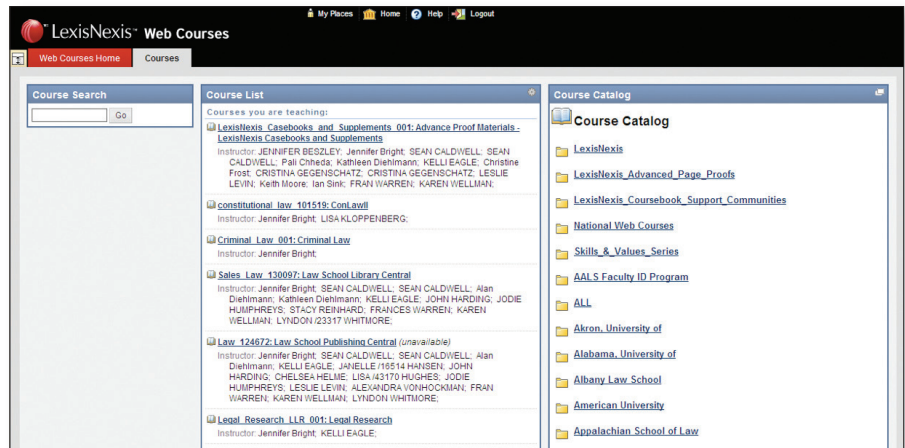
To Access the CSC for a Coursebook:

- Go to the LexisNexis® Law School Portal (www.lexisnexis.com/lawschool).
- Enter your LexisNexis Custom ID and Password (please contact 1-800-455-3947 if you misplaced your Password or need an activation code).
- Once on the home page, select the **Web Courses** tab in the upper-right corner. Web Courses will open in a separate page.

- Click on the courses tab at the top-left of the Web Course page then look for the Course catalog.
- Click on the **LexisNexis Coursebook Support Communities** folder.
- Locate the CSC for the Web Course you would like to review and click **Enroll** to access the course. It will prompt you for an access code. If you do not have an access code, you may obtain one by contacting lawschoolbooksupport@lexisnexis.com
