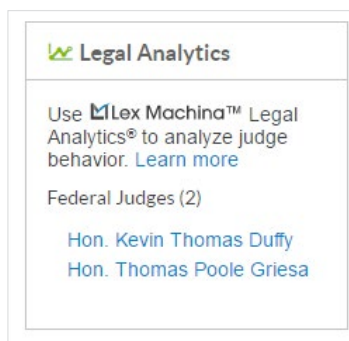

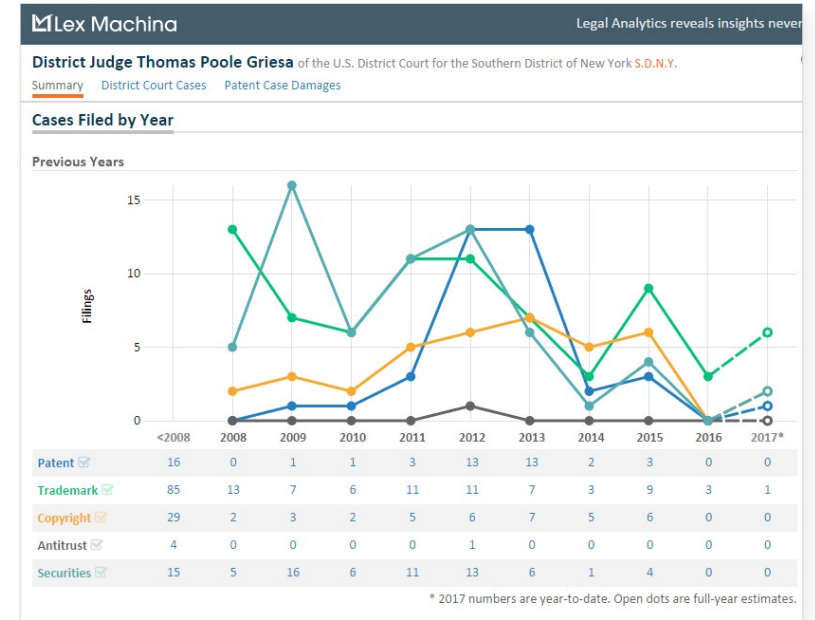

In early 2009, Congress passed the Ledbetter Act to overrule the Supreme Court's decision in Ledbetter v. Goodyear Tire & Rubber Co., 550 U.S. 618, 127 S. Ct. 2162, 167 L. Ed. 2d 982 (2007). In passing the Ledbetter Act, Congress overruled the Court's narrow interpretation of when compensation-based claims accrue. See Schwartz, 665 F.3d at 449. The Ledbetter Act's congressional findings section states: "The limitation imposed by the Court on the filing of discriminatory compensation claims ignores the reality of wage discrimination and is at odds with the robust application of the civil rights laws that Congress intended."

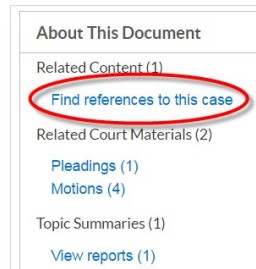
