Set preferred courts for your search results

The new EXPERT segment in Expert Witness content focuses your search to the expert name. Quickly find a specific expert in Expert Witness Testimony and Reports and Expert Witness Challenges.

In response to customer requests, we've added **TRADEMARK and MARK-DESCRIP segments to Lexis Advance Trademarks content**. Use MARK-DESCRIP to refine your search to the description of the trademark. TRADEMARK is a group segment; it restricts your search to the name, word wheel, World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) design, description, lining-stippling, name-consent, pseudomark, Greek and translation fields of the trademark document.
