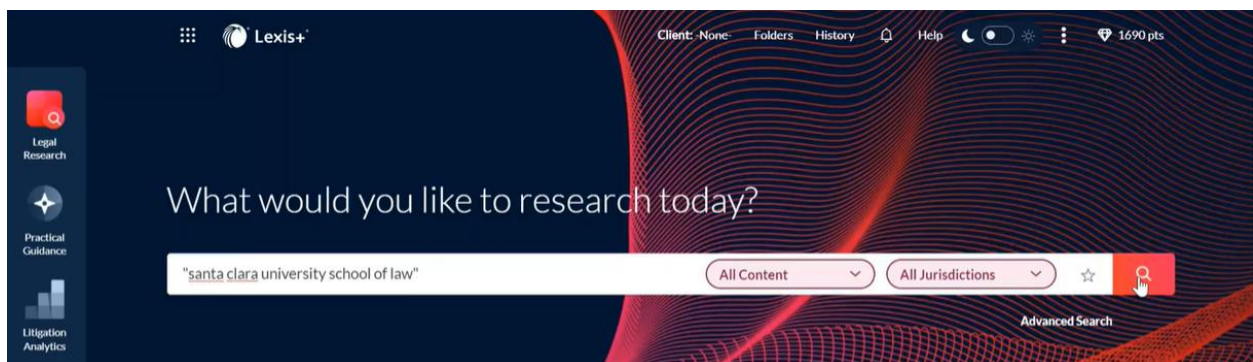


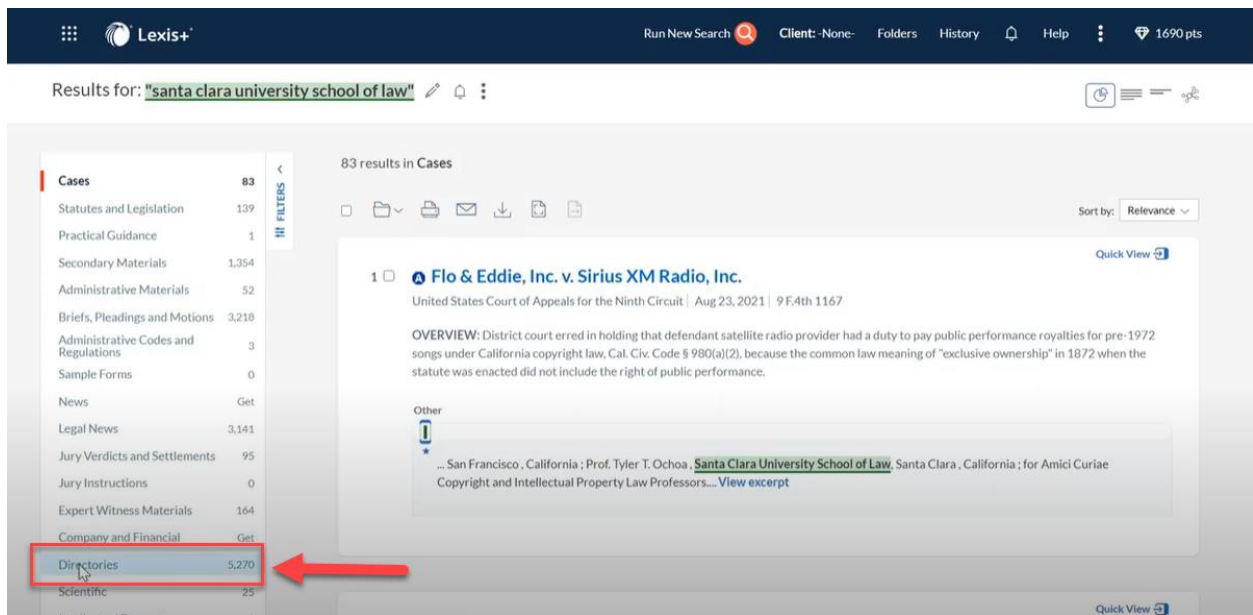
Alumni Searches

Building your professional network is one of the best ways to maximize your success in the job market. Connecting with your alumni base is a fantastic way to learn about new fields and gain inside advocates. Follow the steps below to get started!

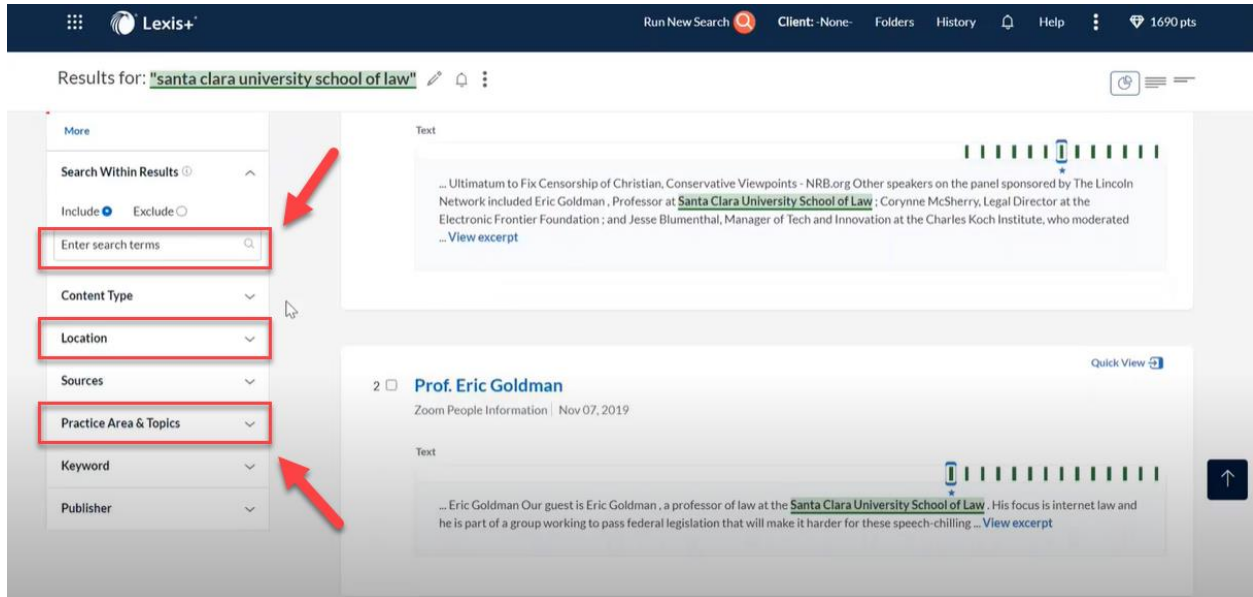
1. Search the name of your school using quotes. (TIP: You can search using your undergrad *or* law school – the goal is to identify & connect with as many alumni as possible working in your field of interest & your preferred location.) Example: Type “Santa Clara University School of Law” in the Red Search Box on the Research homepage.



2. After running a search of your school name, select **Directories** (under the Content drop-down menu at the top-left) to view attorneys, judges & business leaders from your school(s).



3. Narrow the results by location, practice area or additional terms using the **Filters**.



4. **Tip:** Use a terms & connectors search to find alumni working in your preferred firms!
Ex: "Santa Clara University School of Law" /s Fenwick
