Ravel View[™] helps you to quickly find the most influential cases by court and date. You'll instantly locate key cases, uncover overlooked cases, and see the citing relationships between cases in your Lexis+[™] search results.

Top three tips:

ACCESS RAVEL VIEW

To access Ravel View select the citation map icon at the top right of your case law results on Lexis+. This view presents the top 75 case results from your search.

FIND KEY CASES FASTER AND UNCOVER OVERLOOKED CASES

Each circle in the chart represents a case. The larger the circle, the more influential the case. This means the case is cited to more frequently than the other cases in the chart.

Note that the more recent, relevant cases may appear further down your traditional results list. Without Ravel View™, you may have stopped with your first page or two of results and overlooked these cases.

SEE CITING RELATIONSHIPS AND SHEPARD'S® TREATMENT BETWEEN CASES

Ravel View displays *Shepard's* treatment between cases with color coded lines connecting the cases. Click on a case to dive into those connections and use the legend at the bottom of the chart to identify the *Shepard's* treatment corresponding with the color of each line. Hover over any circle of a citing case with *Shepard's* treatment to see the point of law discussed to determine if the other court's analysis is relevant to your research.
