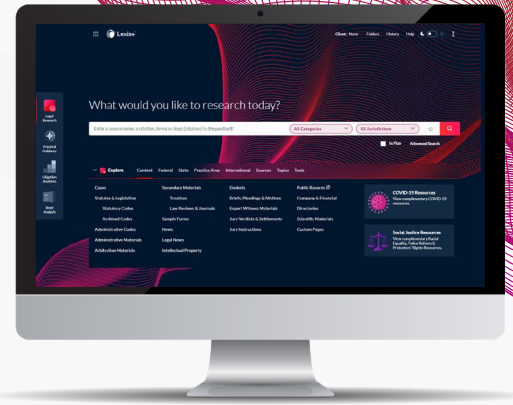


How to Create Strong Outlines
